**DRUG SERVICE (SPECIAL BENEFIT SERVICE)**  
**(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2004**

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the *Drug Service Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Drug Service (Special Benefit Service) (Amendment) Regulations, 2004*.

2. The *Drug Service (Special Benefit Service) Regulations, 1986* are amended by inserting immediately after regulation 4 the following new regulations: S.I. 1986  
No. 65.

“5. A private participating pharmacy shall submit to the Drug Service together with any claim for re-imburement for drugs supplied in accordance with regulation 4, the original prescription that was written by the medical practitioner.

6. The Drug Service shall retain the prescription submitted for the purposes of verifying the claim and shall return the prescription to the pharmacy not later than 3 months from the date of the submission to the Drug Service.”.
