**PHARMACY (QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION OF PHARMACISTS) REGULATIONS, 1986**      1986/79.

**Authority:**      These regulations were made on 21st May, 1986 by the Council, with the approval of the Minister, under section 34 of the *Pharmacy Act*.

**Commencement:**      26th May, 1986.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Pharmacy (Qualifications for Registration of Pharmacists) Regulations, 1986*. Short title.

2. The qualifications for registration as a pharmacist are Qualifications for registration.
- (a) the Barbados Community College Certificate in Basic Pharmacy and certification from the Barbados Community College that the person has satisfactorily completed 6 months Pharmacy internship in Barbados;
  - (b) a degree in pharmacy from a University or College of pharmacy recognised by the Council;
  - (c) a diploma or certificate granted by a body or institution outside of Barbados which diploma or certificate is recognized by the Council as being equivalent to the qualification specified in paragraph (a).
